

CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

The weekend of June 21 - 22 is the Feast of Corpus Christi, when we celebrate our faith in the Holy Eucharist. We will hold our annual Corpus Christi procession on **Saturday, June 21**, immediately following the 5:30 p.m. Mass. It will be a very solemn affair, processing through the streets with the Blessed Sacrament, and we would like all the groups and organizations of our parish to participate with their members and their banners, as a great testimony to our Eucharistic unity. All who have ever taken part in a procession like this know what a great inspiration it can be. If you are from a different country, please come proudly in national dress and let us show the beauty of our multicultural parish, all united in the Eucharist. Following the procession there will be fellowship in the hall with food and drinks. We hope to see all of you there.

RECEIVE THE HOLY SPIRIT

At last! The power hinted at and the Spirit promised are unleashed on this holy day. We call it the birthday of the church. Try to listen to today's scripture passages with some sense of how electrifying these events must have been to those who lived through them. Up until now, they have been waiting in the upper room. In today's first reading, that room is filled with wind and fire and bold proclamations in foreign tongues. In the second reading, Paul describes the Pentecost event, too. His description includes all of us. The Spirit lives on in the church in each of us who are members of the Body of Christ, given different gifts from the same Spirit. Only after Pentecost could the apostles look back and understand what Jesus meant when he said, as reported in today's Gospel reading, "Receive the Holy Spirit." *Copyright © J. S. Paluch Co*

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

Before there was water, there was fire. Once in a while, a volcano hints at the sizzling magma upon which the whole human enterprise floats. Over eons, the surface cooled off a bit, and rain sizzled down for thousands of centuries, filling the oceans and sculpting the earth. We Christians can catch God's glory in a shimmering pool of water, but we can also capture God's burning desire to fan the tiny flames of our baptismal candles into something that will make a difference. In Sicily to this day, there is a custom of scattering rose petals down from the ceiling of church on the heads of the faithful, an effective reminder of the "tongues of flame" descending on the apostles, and a sign that the Holy Spirit still is poured out on the baptized. It is not merely a quaint custom, but a fairly potent sign of what baptism does. An interesting sidebar: if you have traced the Epiphany blessing on your doorway in chalk, Pentecost is the day to erase it. From now on, no need to rely on the "wise men"—you are alive in the Spirit!

SAFEGUARD THE CHILDREN

A healthy scrutiny of programs for kids helps create a healthy environment

It is not a best practice for a parent, guardian, employer, or manager to blindly trust everyone who works with children. Yet, paranoia of those who work with children is also not a best practice. There is a healthy balance. By regularly and frequently questioning the actions and motives of those who work with children, parents and other adults can audit the programs their children participate in and help keep caregivers accountable for their work. In this process, parents and other adults can create a constant fear of being caught in the mind of a perpetrator. By channeling this kind of healthy scrutiny and suspicion into accountability, adults can create an environment where children are protected, quality care is emulated, and abuse is not tolerated. Escrutinio de los programas de niños ayudaría a crear ambientes saludables

No es la mejor práctica para padres, guardianes, empleadores o gerentes el confiar ciegamente en todos los que trabajan con niños. Sin embargo, la paranoia con quienes trabajan con niños tampoco es la mejor práctica. Existe un balance saludable. El cuestionar regular y frecuentemente las acciones y motivaciones de quienes trabajan con niños, padres y otros adultos, puede servir de auditoría de los programas en los que sus niños participan y ayudar a mantener a los guardianes responsables del trabajo que hacen. En este proceso, los padres y otros adultos pueden crear un temor constante de ser sorprendidos con la mente de un perpetrador. Al canalizar este tipo de escrutinio saludable y asumir responsabilidad, los adultos pueden crear un ambiente donde los niños sean protegidos, donde exista calidad en el cuidado y donde el abuso no sea tolerado.
