CORPUS CHRISTI PROCESSION

The weekend of June 21 - 22 is the Feast of Corpus Christi, when we celebrate our faith in the Holy Eucharist. We will hold our annual Corpus Christi procession on **Saturday, June 21**, immediately following the 5:30 p.m. Mass. It will be a very solemn affair, processing through the streets with the Blessed Sacrament, and we would like all the groups and organizations of our parish to participate with their members and their banners, as a great testimony to our Eucharistic unity. All who have ever taken part in a procession like this know what a great inspiration it can be. If you are from a different country, please come proudly in national dress and let us show the beauty of our multicultural parish, all united in the Eucharist. Following the procession there will be fellowship in the hall with food and drinks. We hope to see all of you there.

LIFE IN THE TRINITY

The name of the Trinity is, without a doubt, the most familiar sacred name to us. We speak it every time we make the sign of the cross, and it forms the heart of our Creed. Trinity Sunday is a good day, however, to stop and reflect on the unique role of each of the three persons we name so often in the Trinity and in our own lives. When we celebrate the Eucharist on Sunday, we come together as the Body of Christ through our baptism, and through the power of the Holy Spirit we offer the whole prayer of the Mass to God the Father. This presence of the Trinity does not stop when we leave church on Sunday. We are—always and everywhere—members of the Body, and every thing we do as members of that Body is empowered by the Holy Spirit, all of it offered to the glory of our loving Father. Take a moment each day this week to reflect on how the persons of the Trinity were present to you during the day, and how other people came to see the presence of the Trinity in your witness to the Good News.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

The liturgy seems reluctant to return to Ordinary Time from the joys of Easter, and so the festivities extend to today's celebration of the mystery of God's relationship to us as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The Gospel today centers the question of our relationship with God in the struggle of Nathaniel to believe that it is possible to experience "rebirth" in the Spirit. The answer of Jesus is that God's response to the messes of this world is the mystery of saving love in Jesus Christ and the outpouring of an empowering Spirit. Western church architecture often tops a church building with a spire, indicating humanity's reach to a transcendent God. The Eastern Church responds with onion-shaped domes, indicating the Spirit's being poured down upon humanity precisely at this locale, the gathering of the faithful for the Divine Liturgy. This familiar design encodes a great mystery: here, at the Lord's table, we experience the outpouring of the Spirit for the life of the world. Nathaniel came to Jesus by night, since he was still working out the meaning of his life. A life attuned to the inner life of the Trinity must always be given to the light of day.



SAFEGUARD THE CHILDREN

By teaching "total body safety" we further efforts to stop child sexual abuse

When teaching parents, stress that their child's entire body is private and to be watchful of adults who might be "grooming" a child by constantly tickling, kissing, or hugging them. A child will often tell a parent he or she does not want to hug or kiss someone. Teach parents to listen to their children and respect their wishes! Stress to teens the importance of "total body safety" in their relationships with others. Tell them, "Just because a person is a close friend or even a girlfriend or boyfriend, that does not give them a right to touch you in a way that makes you feel uncomfortable." By teaching "total body safety" to adults, children, and young people, we are furthering our efforts to stop child sexual abuse and to make the world a safer place for all of God's children. Por lo regular, un niño le dice a su padre o madre si ella o él no quiere que alguien la/lo abrace o besé. ¡Enseñe a los padres a escuchar a sus hijos y a respetar sus deseos! Insista con los adolescentes sobre la importancia de la “seguridad corporal total” en sus relaciones con los demás. Dígales, “Sólo porque una persona es una amistad cercana o aun un amigo o amiga, eso no les da derecho para tocarte en una forma que te haga sentir incómodo”. Al enseñar “seguridad corporal total” a adultos, niños y a jóvenes, estamos avanzando en nuestros esfuerzos para detener el abuso sexual infantil y hacer del mundo un lugar más seguro para todos los hijos de Dios. 
