The Old Testament reading recounts a young man's radical break with the past to follow a new path. The Gospel describes how life as we know it is abruptly changed if we follow the call of Christ. The psalm and Paul assure us that such life-altering change is possible only because of the power of God's love. We are presented with a stark choice. To love as God loves, we must leave our old lives behind. We must leave behind not just the bad, the selfish, and the evil but the ordinary, our daily work, and the important, our families, our lives. ## SAFEGUARD THE CHILDREN

### Know the signs of a potential predator

It's not always easy to spot someone who has malicious intentions towards children in your community. Although we have sex offender registries and certifications for adults who work with children, predators can slip through the cracks. Adults who are in regular contact with children — parents, grandparents, caregivers, etc. — should know the warning signs of a potential predator. Often, potential abusers will go overboard with touching children, wrestling, tickling, giving hugs and kisses. Other red flags including wanting to be alone with children or giving gifts, often without checking in with the parents first. ### Conozca las señales de un potencial depredador

No siempre es fácil detectar a alguien que tiene intenciones maliciosas hacia los niños en su comunidad. Aunque los adultos que trabajan enseñando y cuidando a los niños, tienen registros y certificaciones de delincuentes sexuales, los depredadores pueden pasar desapercibidos. Los adultos que están en contacto regular con niños (padres, abuelos, cuidadores, etc.) deben conocer las señales de advertencia de un posible depredador. A menudo, los abusadores potenciales se van por la borda tocando a los niños, luchando, haciendo cosquillas, dando abrazos y besos. Otras señales de alerta podrían ser querer estar a solas con los niños o dar regalos, a menudo sin consultar con los padres primero.
