# Being Prepared

In this Sunday's Gospel we hear the Parable of the Ten

Virgins, also known as the Parable of the Wise and Foolish Virgins or the Parable of the ten bridesmaids. The wise or righteous virgins were those prepared for the coming of the bridegroom, while the foolish virgins were unprepared and were left outside in the darkness.

In its broader message, the parable reminds us that those who are not leading virtuous lives are not prepared for the coming of Christ and will have the gates of heaven closed to them.

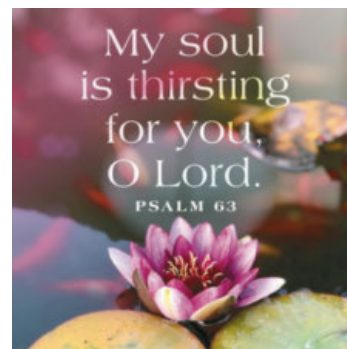
**PARISH LIFE****THANKSGIVING DAY MASS**

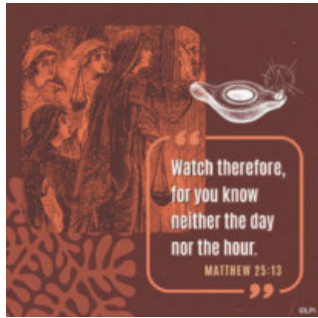
