# The Light of World

Last Friday, February 2, the Church celebrated the fest of the Presentation of the Lord, also known as the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The feast commemorates the presentation of Jesus to the Temple as mentioned in the Gospel of Luke, "When the days were completed for their purification according to the law of Moses, they took him up to Jerusalem to present him to the Lord." (Luke 2:22).

The feast is also known as Candlemas, referring to the blessing of candles that occurs on this day, in recognition of Jesus being "a light for revelation to the Gentiles." (Luke: 2:32).





# **REQUESTING USE OF PARISH FACILITIES**


