SAFEGUARD THE CHILDREN

Age-appropriate curiosity in school-aged children

Last week, we covered young children and natural curiosity about their bodies. This week, we will explore natural curiosity behaviors in school-aged children (around 7-12 years old). It's important to understand the difference between appropriate and inappropriate, as inappropriate behaviors could be a sign of abuse. Common curiosity at this age includes playing games with same-aged friends like "family" or "dating," or wanting privacy. Children at these ages may also begin to take an interest in members of the opposite sex and ask questions about relationships. PROTEGIENDO A LOS NIÑOS

Curiosidad de niños de edad escolar apropiada para su edad

La semana pasada hablamos sobre los niños pequeños y la curiosidad natural de su cuerpo. Esta semana hablaremos de la curiosidad natural de los niños en edad escolar (entre 7 y 12 años) y de los comportamientos apropiados para su edad. Es importante entender la diferencia entre lo apropiado e inapropiado, ya que el conducto inapropiado podría ser un signo del abuso. La curiosidad habitual a esta edad incluye jugar con amigos de la misma edad que son "familia" o "novios", o querer tiempo solo. Los niños de estas edades también pueden empezar a interesarse de los miembros del sexo opuesto y a hacer preguntas sobre las relaciones.
