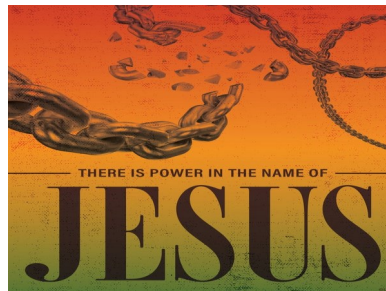

### GOSPEL MEDITATION

A few years ago, I met a woman in my parish who was a successful lawyer. Yet in her free time, she poured her energy into a nonprofit she founded to advocate for children with special needs. When I asked what inspired her, she spoke of her niece, who was born with disabilities. Her niece was both a glorious gift and a constant challenge. Out of that painful, beautiful experience, she felt called to create something lasting for other children and parents. The nonprofit thrived, not because she had mapped it all out, but because she was deeply moved to act. In today's Gospel, Jesus is *"moved with compassion" for the crowd, for they were "like sheep without a shepherd."* (Matthew 9:36) So he calls his disciples, ordinary men with no special qualifications, and sends them to heal, preach, and cast out demons. Their mission flows not from their skills but from his authority and the Spirit's gifts.

**The Second Vatican Council teaches that the Spirit continually pours out charisms, special graces for the good of the Church and the world (cf. Lumen Gentium 4 & 12).** These often arise from the unfolding of our lives: from what breaks your heart, what fills you with hope, what suffering has shaped you. The Spirit works through those very experiences to equip us with gifts that build up others.

What is your charism? Well, what needs around you call you to loving action? This could be where Christ is sending you. Allow your heart to be moved like Christ's. Then get to work.

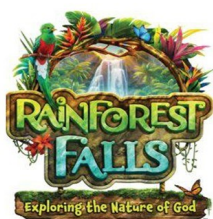

## SJW MEMORIAL SOCIETY

St. Joseph the Worker Memorial Society is intended as a meaningful and beautiful way for persons to remember their beloved deceased or to express their condolences to friends who have lost a loved one. Persons enrolled in the Memorial Society will share in the spiritual benefits of special Masses and prayers offered throughout the year, every year. A Mass is offered for those enrolled every first Saturday of the month at our 8:30 a.m. Mass. The enrollment list is kept in the Parish Center and is accessible during office hours. Each memorial is presented in a handsome leatherette folder, containing an enrollment card where the name of the person remembered is inscribed, along with the person who enrolled the deceased. The leatherette folder with personalized enrollment card is particularly suitable on the occasion of a death, to bring to a viewing or funeral, or to send as an anniversary remembrance. ## SAFEGUARD THE CHILDREN

### Reporting child online sexual exploitation

If your children are exposed to exploitive and abusive materials online, or if you discover such materials online, please report these exposures to help protect other children and families. You can report an incident to the National Center for Missing & Exploited Children (NCMEC) 24/7 at report.cybertip.org. Include the username of the person who shared explicit content, when it happened, what URL was used, and any other relevant information. NCMEC will work with law enforcement officials to start an investigation and shut down inappropriate activity. NCMEC also has materials and resources to help parents and children begin to recover from being exposed to exploitive and abusive materials online. To learn more, visit missingkids.org.

### Cómo denunciar la explotación sexual infantil

Si sus hijos están expuestos a materiales abusivos y de explotación en línea, o si descubre dichos materiales en línea, reporte estas exposiciones para ayudar a proteger a otros niños y a familias. Puede reportar un incidente al Centro Nacional para Niños Desaparecidos y Explotados (NCMEC, por sus siglas en inglés) las 24 horas del día, los 7 días de la semana en [report.cybertip.org](http://report.cybertip.org). Incluya el nombre de usuario de la persona que compartió contenido explícito, cuándo sucedió, qué URL se usó y cualquier otra información relevante. El NCMEC trabajará con las autoridades policiales para iniciar una investigación y eliminar la actividad inapropiada. El NCMEC también tiene materiales y recursos para ayudar a los padres de familia y a los niños a comenzar a recuperarse de la exposición a materiales abusivos y de explotación en línea. Todos debemos cooperar para que el Reino de Dios crezca; todos somos pueblo de Dios y ovejas de su rebaño (Salmo 99). "Ustedes lo recibieron sin pagar, denlo sin cobrar" (Mateo 10:8). Es la gratitud de la fe la que nos mantiene en pie de lucha. Dios nos da a manos llenas; su misericordia se manifiesta de diferentes maneras: en la familia, en el trabajo, en la universidad, y, en fin, en cada amanecer Él está con nosotros. Por lo tanto, urge que colaboremos con Dios de alguna forma: "Rueguen, pues, al dueño de la cosecha que envíe trabajadores a recoger la cosecha" (Mateo 9:38). ©LPI

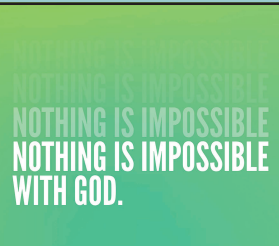
