**GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE**

*"He breathed on them and said to them, 'Receive the Holy Spirit. Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them, and whose sins you retain are retained.'" (John 20:22-23)*

For those of us who go to confession regularly, there is often a familiar frustration: "Why do I keep confessing the same sins?" It can feel like a loop, cleansed but unchanged.

Pentecost reveals a hopeful perspective. When the Risen Jesus breathes on his ashamed and fearful disciples and gives them the Holy Spirit, he echoes Genesis, when God breathes life into Adam. This is not just primarily the removal of guilt, but new creation.

In confession, we receive more than forgiveness. We receive a fresh outpouring, the breath of the Spirit, and a renewed mission. Jesus does not say to us, "You're forgiven, now go back to your old life." He says, so to speak, *"As the Father has sent me, so I send you."* (John 20:21)

That is why penance is not just saying a few prayers. It is reorientation. It is the Spirit summoning us to live differently: with mercy and healing.

Just as Adam was sent into the world, and the Apostles were sent out after Pentecost, so too we are sent from the confessional — not just clean, but consecrated.

**Pentecost Challenge:** After your next confession, ask the Holy Spirit for one way you can participate in Christ's healing will for you. Then take one small, concrete step, and do not look back.

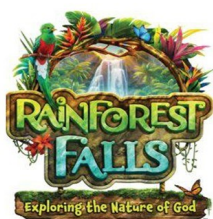

## SJW MEMORIAL SOCIETY

St. Joseph the Worker Memorial Society is intended as a meaningful and beautiful way for persons to remember their beloved deceased or to express their condolences to friends who have lost a loved one. Persons enrolled in the Memorial Society will share in the spiritual benefits of special Masses and prayers offered throughout the year, every year. A Mass is offered for those enrolled every first Saturday of the month at our 8:30 a.m. Mass. The enrollment list is kept in the Parish Center and is accessible during office hours. ## SAFEGUARD THE CHILDREN

**Know the signs of potential abuse for vulnerable adults**  
 Keeping children from harm is essential, but it is just as important to prioritize the protection of vulnerable adults. A vulnerable adult is someone who, due to a physical, mental, emotional, or behavior condition, may not be able to protect themselves from harm or exploitation. Warning signs of abuse can include injuries, signs of apparent malnutrition or dehydration, soiled clothing or bedding, anxiety, and unclean living conditions. By understanding the reality of vulnerable adult abuse, considering our own behavior, learning warning signs and communicating concerns - we can strive to protect other who may not be in a position to protect themselves. ## PROTEGIENDO A LOS NIÑOS

### Reconoce las señales de abuso potencial en adultos vulnerables

Proteger a los niños de cualquier daño es fundamental, pero es igual de importante dar prioridad a la protección de los adultos vulnerables. Los adultos vulnerables son aquellos que, debido a una condición física, mental, emocional o conductual, puede no ser capaz de protegerse a sí misma de cualquier daño o explotación. Las señales del maltrato pueden incluir lesiones, signos evidentes de desnutrición o deshidratación, ropa o sábanas sucias, condiciones de vida insalubres y ansiedad. Si comprendemos la realidad del maltrato a los adultos vulnerables, reflexionamos sobre nuestro propio comportamiento, aprendemos a reconocer las señales y comunicamos nuestras preocupaciones, podemos luchar por proteger a otras personas que quizá no estén en condiciones de protegerse a sí mismas.
